Nitish suffered burns to 65% of his body and is in "very, very critical condition," unlikely to survive. He needs skin grafting, but there is not enough skin left on his body to be used. Nitish and his family converted to Christianity 2 yrs ago and regularly holds Christian gatherings in their home. He and his older brother have conducted daily prayer gatherings. A month before the attack, extremists told the village they would expel Christians. Please pray for Nitish, his family, and Christians in India.
