



Persecution: Imprisoned Iranian Christians

In November & December of 2020, KBC reported on nine Iranian Christians imprisoned of for "acting against national security" & "promoting Zionism": Behnam Akhlagi, Babak Hosseinzadeh, Mehdi Khatibi, Hossein Kadivar, Khalil Dehghanpour, Mohammad Vafadar, Shahrouz Eslamdoust, Kamal Naamanian, & Addolreza Ali (Matthias) Haghnejad. All nine are members of the Church of Iran and were leading the church in the absence of their pastor, Yousef Nadarkhani, who is serving a 10-year sentence. In 2020, they lost their appeal against their 5-year prison sentences. This last November, the Iranian Supreme Court announced that they did not consider proselytizing & home church establishment to be illegal activities, so the high court is reviewing the nine's 5-year prison sentences.
