

PRAYER REQUESTS

Persecution: Nigerian Student, Deborah Emmanuel Yakubu Deborah, a Christian college student in Northwest Nigeria, was killed Thursday, May 12, for allegedly blaspheming the prophet of Islam. As information was released, it was discovered that Deborah had turned down a Muslim's proposal to date her. This led him to falsely accuse that she had blasphemed in a WhatsApp group chat. In reality, she had complained in the group chat about the discrimination of Christian students in the school and also stated she passed her exams thanks to Christ. When pressured to retract the statement and apologize, she declined and urged fellow group members to refrain from discussing religion.

A mob of Muslims students dragged Deborah from her hostel,

stoned her to death, then burned her shouting "Allahu akbar (God is greater)" while filming. Passersby were told to join if they were Muslim, according to eyewitnesses. Two students have been arrested in connection with the killing and the school has been closed.
