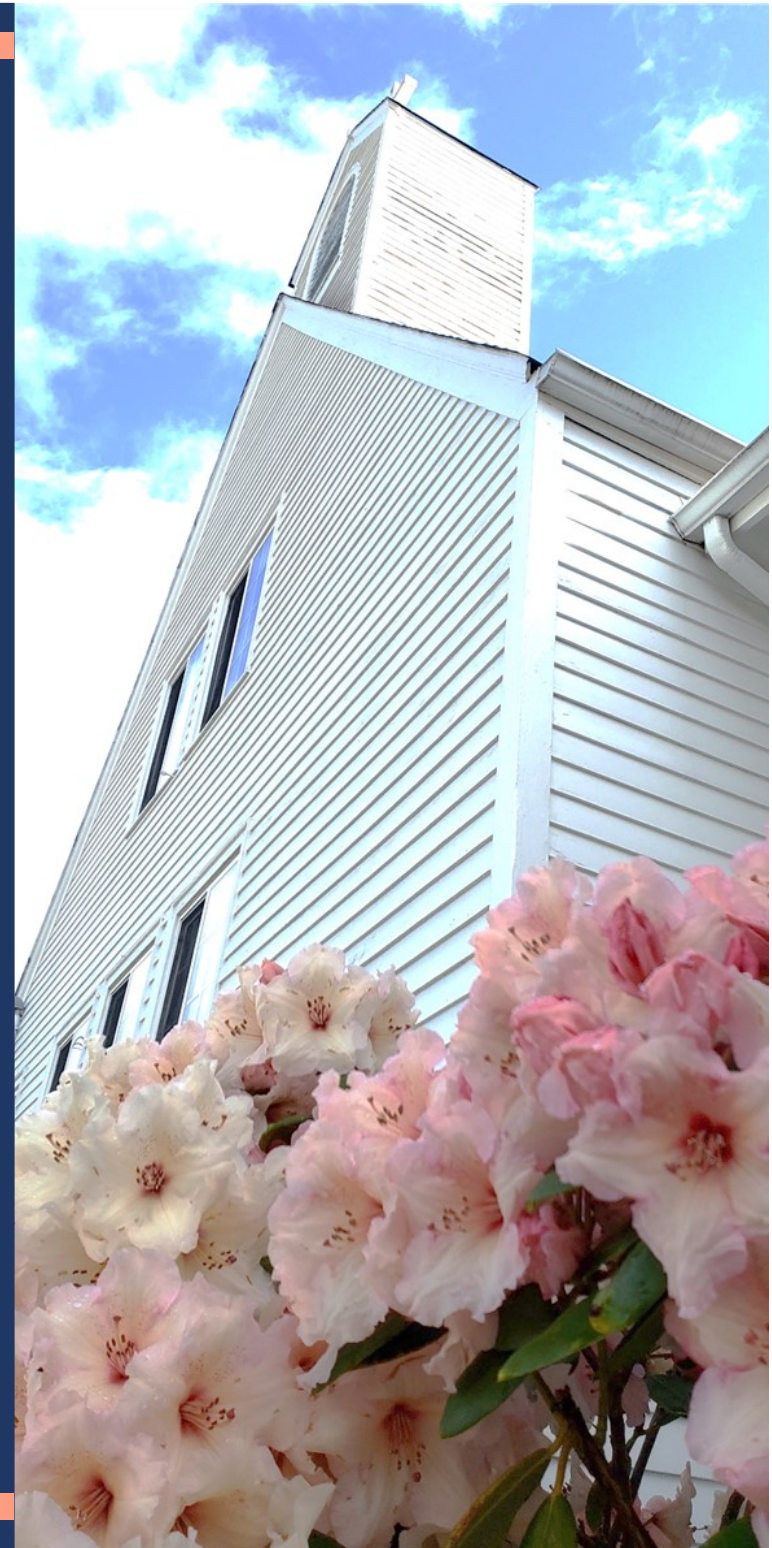

PRAYER REQUESTS: CONGO PRAYER REQUEST from the newsletter of IFCA International: IFCA member Sam Felten is asking for prayer as he and a team from South County Bible Church (St. Louis, MO) head out to the Congo. He writes:

"Justin, Victor, and I leave for the Congo on September 3rd, God willing. Justin's people are the Banyamulenge, located primarily in Minembwe. They have been persecuted, their homes and Bibles burned, cows stolen, many executed, and women raped. Most only eat twice a week. On our last trip, Victor and I preached to the pastors and women in conferences and urged them to let go of bitterness and ask God to help them forgive. God moved in their hearts profoundly. They took this message back to all their congregations so that now we have about 100,000 people who have asked God to help them forgive their enemies. They have now invited 30 unsaved pastors from the enemy tribe to join them for the pastor's conference we are holding on September 8 -10. They have agreed to come. Justin's people are earnestly praying that God would save these men and use them to bring the gospel back to their people and bring about reconciliation. Would you join us in earnestly praying for God to save and work through these men to bring thousands to Christ and bring reconciliation among these people? Thank you for praying."
